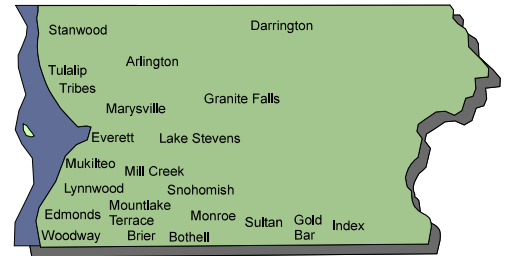

a. Housing Characteristics and Needs Report Update, Amber Piona

Amber Piona, Senior Planner at Snohomish County, gave an update on the Housing Characteristics and Needs Report timeline.

Commerce has been updating their allocation tool. It was partially updated in December and Commerce has said it will be fully updated in February. The partial update shows an increase in Snohomish County’s housing need. The SCT Working Group has paused meetings until February when the final housing allocation numbers are available.

b. 2024 Comprehensive Plan Update, Status Report, Sarah Titcomb

Sarah Titcomb, Senior Planner at Snohomish County, gave a status report on the 2024 Comprehensive Plan Update and in particular opportunities for public engagement.

There are six planned phases of review for each element, and each includes a 30-day public comment period. Following the 30-day public comment periods, each element will go to Planning Commission for public hearings. These public hearings are scheduled to start in late October. Following the public hearings at Planning Commission, the County Council will hold public hearings will begin in late 3rd quarter of 2024.

The Passport to 2044 Series continues into 2023. On February 15th there is a session on housing need and capacity. There will be another event focused on equity data tools and assessments. It is coming soon, there is no date set at this time.
