**Accident Investigation**

On March 15, 2012 at approximately 2:00am, Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a one-vehicle accident at Cypress Way and 204<sup>th</sup> Street Southwest, Lynnwood WA. Preliminary investigation indicates the vehicle, a Toyota passenger car, was traveling eastbound on 204<sup>th</sup> Street Southwest when it failed to stop at a stop sign, crossed the intersection and struck a power pole. The driver of the vehicle, a 28 year old female from Kirkland, and the passenger, a 32 year old male from Kirkland, were both trapped inside the vehicle. Both occupants sustained serious injuries, however none appeared life threatening. Both were transported to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle.

The Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit was called out to conduct the investigation. The cause of the accident is unknown, however alcohol and/or speed have not been ruled out as possible factors. Snohomish County PUD was called out to handle the downed power lines at the location.
