One Car-Fatality Accident Investigation

On April 27, 2012 at approximately 7:20pm, Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a one vehicle fatality accident in the 2800 block of Turk Road, Marysville WA. Preliminary information indicates the victim driver, a 20 year old female from Marysville, was traveling westbound on Turk Road when she failed to negotiate a left turn and her Chrysler 4-door left the roadway and struck a tree. The victim, who was not wearing a seat belt at the time of the accident, was pronounced deceased at the scene. The passenger, a 19 year old female from Marysville, was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Detectives with the Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit were called to investigate the accident. At this time, it appears alcohol may have played a factor in the accident. Also, detectives are investigating whether the victim's vehicle was involved in a hit and run accident which occurred in the general area just prior to the fatality accident.
