Felony Assault Investigation

On November 3, 2011 at approximately 9:14pm, Snohomish County Sheriff's deputies were dispatched to a report of a possible stabbing in the 16400 block of May Creek Road, Gold Bar. Upon arrival, deputies determined that two neighbors who both live in the area had become involved in an altercation with one another after both had consumed alcohol. During this altercation one neighbor had stabbed the other neighbor in the upper back with a knife. The victim in this incident, a 58 year old male, was transported to Providence Hospital (Colby Campus) where he was treated for non-life threatening injuries and released. The suspect in this incident, a 40 year old male, was transported to Evergreen Hospital where he was treated for a minor injury to his hand and released. Upon being released, the suspect was arrested by deputies and booked into the Snohomish County Jail on one count of First Degree Assault, one count of Second Degree Assault and one count of First Degree Burglary.

Detectives from the Sheriff's Office Major Crimes Unit responded to the scene and continue to investigate this incident.
