FATALITY COLLISION

Snohomish, WA

At 9pm Saturday night emergency services personnel responded to a one car rollover collision in the 23300 block of Woods Creek Road in unincorporated Snohomish County. The vehicle was southbound when it left the road down an embankment crashing into a tree on its roof. The driver was a 27 year old local man who died at the scene. The 16 year old female passenger in the front seat was airlifted to Harborview with serious injuries. The 19 year old male passenger seated in the rear of the car was not injured and was able to provide investigators information regarding the crash.

The crash is being investigated by the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit. Initial findings indicate speed was a factor in this collision; no determination has been made regarding driver impairment. The identities of the parties involved will not be released at this time due to minor status and positive identification.

There are no other details available at this time.
