

ROAD CLOSURE IN AUGUST 2022

156th St SE Drainage Pipe Replacement



Snohomish County is replacing a failing 24-inch drainage pipe that crosses 156th St SE in the 8500 block. The new pipe will be 36 inches to accommodate a higher capacity of water.

Schedule


Construction is expected to occur in August and last for two weeks. Construction crews will be working Monday – Thursday, approximately 7 a.m. – 4 p.m.


Traffic Impacts

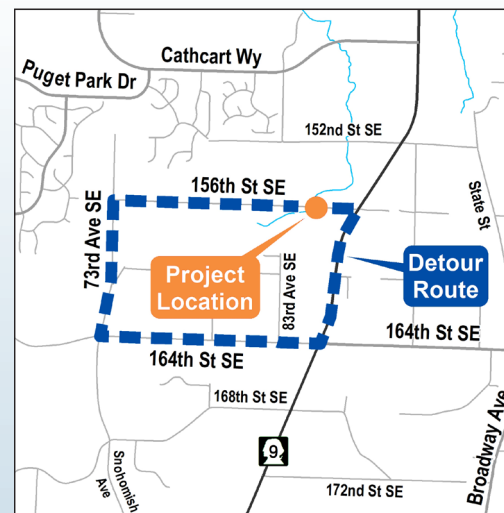
This project will require a two-week 24/7 full-road closure. There will be a detour route (see map).
