Applications for an estimated \$1 million in federal funds for public facilities and infrastructure will be accepted until January 20, 2023.

SNOHOMISH COUNTY, Wash., December 20, 2022 - Snohomish County is encouraging nonprofit organizations and government agencies to review the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) and submit applications for public facilities and infrastructure projects.

An estimated \$1,061,852 in federal funds is anticipated to be available for the 2023 program year, which begins July 1, 2023. Projects must benefit low- and moderate-income persons or neighborhoods in Snohomish County.
