

NOTICE OF RULE ADOPTION
SNOHOMISH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF
CONSERVATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES

Notice Date: April 5, 2023

Rule Title: CNR Departmental Rule 2023-01 - Procedures for Ensuring Compliance with Chapters 30.63A (Drainage), and 30.63B (Land Disturbing Activity) SCC and other applicable chapters of Title 30 SCC for Projects Performed By the Surface Water Management Division of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources Pursuant to SCC 30.63A.040 and SCC 30.63B.100. These projects are hereinafter referred to as “SWM Projects”.

Proposed Rule: The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (CNR) proposed adoption of CNR Departmental Rule 2023-01 on February 15, 2023. In accordance with SCC 30.82.030(1) the rule was made available for public comment, with a comment period from February 17, 2023 to March 17, 2023. One comment was received.

CNR Director Decision: The CNR Director reviewed the comment and has adopted CNR Departmental Rule 2023-01 without amendment in accordance with SCC 30.82.040(1).

Effective Date: CNR Departmental Rule 2023-01 took effect on March 31, 2023.

Request for County Council Review: Pursuant to SCC 30.82.065, an interested person may request County Council review of the CNR Director’s decision by submitting a written request to the CNR Director or the contact person listed below by July 29, 2023 (120 days from effective date). Council review will determine whether the adopted rule is consistent with the scope of CNR rulemaking authority per SCC 30.82.010(1). No other appeal opportunity is available.
