



ROAD WORK BEGINS IN JULY

Locust Way Culvert Replacement

Snohomish County Surface Water Management (SWM), a division of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources is replacing a culvert on Trickle Creek located at 23325 Locust Way. The current culvert is failing and is a barrier to fish passage. It will be replaced with a structure designed to allow fish passage.

Schedule

Construction is expected to begin in early July and be completed by the end of October. Construction crews will be working Monday – Friday during daylight hours.


Traffic Impacts


Construction will require a full 24/7 closure of Locust way at 23325 Locust Way, with detour route shown on the map. The closure is expected to last up to three months.

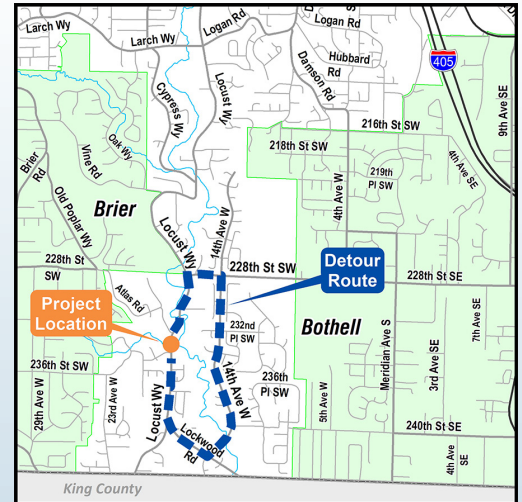

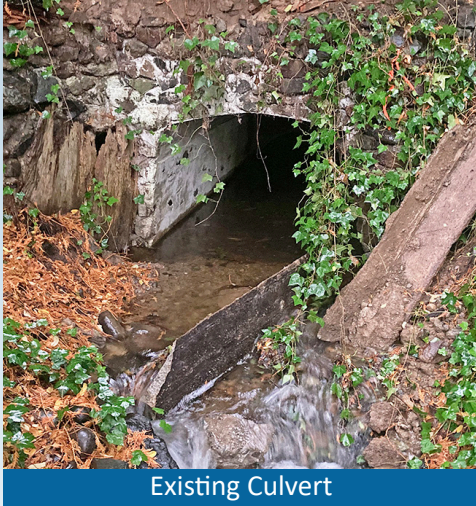
