

Phase 1: FY2023 CoC Local Application Q&A

The FY2023 HUD Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for Continuum of Care (CoC) funding has not been released as of the date of this publication. The responses in this FY2023 CoC Local Application Q&A are based on policy priorities and eligible project types from prior HUD CoC NOFO's. When the FY2023 CoC NOFO is released and eligible project types varies from what is listed below, responses will be updated to reflect policy priorities and eligible project types as appropriate.

Q: Can an Agency applying for a renewal project seek additional funds for the project?

A: It is anticipated that Agencies may be able to apply for increased funds in Phase 2 for project expansions. Previous NOFOs have allowed projects that receive CoC funding to apply for an expansion by adding or increasing units, persons served, type of services, and/or level of services in the project. Regardless of expansion, Agencies would still need to complete and submit a Standard Renewal or Renewal Less than One Year application in Phase 1 if they want to apply for continued renewal funding for the project past June 30, 2024 for the FY2023 operating period - July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025. Please also note that during the FY2023 CoC Competition process, for renewal projects awarded funding, it is anticipated that HUD will automatically make any required adjustments to existing rental assistance, leasing, and operating budget line item amounts based on Fair Market Rent (FMR) changes; this may result in increased funding for these line items at the time of award.
