Based on the County's adopted growth targets to support the County's Future Land Use Map in planning to serve the anticipated growth;

Contains capital facilities and services provided by the County and external agencies;

Underscores the need for coordination between and among municipalities, special purposed districts, and other providers

Key Capital Facilities and Utilities Element Amendments for the 2024 Update

Key Capital Facilities and Utilities Policy Amendments for the 2024 Update

- Updates existing inventories, and forecasts of future needs.
- Updates level of service standard for capital facilities and utilities deemed necessary to support development.
- Establishes those capital facilities and utilities necessary to support development, distinguishing between urban and rural areas.
- New policies to support broadband access and expansion.
- New policies to support the efforts to decarbonize and increase electric vehicle infrastructure.
- New policies to enhance the county's resiliency.
