## Start using your benefits in just 3 steps!

### Step 1: Select your Primary Care Dentist (PCD)

- > Click on 'Online Tools' and use our 'Find a Dentist' tool
- > Select 'DeltaCare' to filter your search results

### Dental Emergencies

Your PCD will help you access emergency care, 24 hours a day, every day of the year.

You can select a different PCD for each member of your family. If you don't select a PCD, we will assign one for you.

### Step 2: Enroll in your DeltaCare Plan

Complete the enrollment form provided by your employer. Be sure to indicate your PCD and the PCD for your dependents.

### Step 3: Schedule your appointment

After you've enrolled, you'll receive your identification/insurance cards along with the address and phone number of your PCD. Contact them to make an appointment.



**It's important that you receive all of your dental care from your PCD or PCD-referred specialist. Your DeltaCare plan only covers services provided by your PCD or PCD-referred specialist. If you don't see a DeltaCare dentist, you are responsible for paying all costs for dental services.**

### Visit your PCD regularly

Your plan covers preventive care visits each year. Regular cleanings and check-ups are essential to keeping your smile healthy and preventing painful, expensive problems down the road.

### How to change your PCD

You can change your PCD whenever you want. Be sure to confirm your new dentist is a DeltaCare PCD. Then, give us a call to tell us the name of your new PCD. Make your change request by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month to start seeing your new dentist on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the following month.

### Get out-of-pocket cost estimates

When you need extensive treatment, like a crown, ask your dentist for a "Predetermination." You'll get a **Confirmation of Treatment and Cost** from us. It details your dentist's treatment plan, what your benefits cover, and how much you may owe your dentist for the treatment.
