

SNOHOMISH COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFIC INVESTIGATIVE CHECKLIST

ROBBERY IN THE SECOND DEGREE

RCW 9A.56.210

ELEMENTS

1. The suspect unlawfully took personal property from the person of another OR in that person's presence; AND
2. the taking was against that person's will; AND
3. the taking was with intent to deprive the possessor of the property (not necessarily permanently); AND
4. the suspect used or threatened to use immediate force, violence or fear of injury to the victim, to another person, or to their property; AND
5. such force or fear was used to obtain or retain possession of the property, OR to overcome resistance to the taking.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

- [] 1. If robbery occurred in or near a business, obtain any available surveillance video capturing the suspect for the period immediately preceding, during and after the robbery
- [] 2. Identify the precise nature of any threat used and what effect such threat had on the victim.
- [] 3. If the property stolen belonged to someone other than the person from whom it was taken, obtain a statement from the property owner regarding lack of permission and the amount of loss.
- [] 4. If the suspect is an accomplice, determine and detail what evidence exists to prove/disprove that the suspect knew his/her aid would facilitate the crime.
- [] 5. Determine and detail what evidence exists to prove/disprove the prior relationship between the suspect and the victim.
