### What is proposed?

Snohomish County Public Works plans to improve the sight distance for drivers at the intersection of **67<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE and 132<sup>nd</sup> St. NE**. The proposal is to lower the grade on 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE about two feet. Approximately 500 feet of 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE will be regraded. Under-ground and overhead utilities will be relocated as necessary. The roadway will be paved and all disturbed areas seeded following regrading.

### When will this be built?

This project is planned to be constructed in **late 2013** and take about 30 days. A detour is planned during construction. Local access will be provided for residents.
