Whatcom LIO Contract (Excerpt)

Subtask 3.03 Establish and implement a Whatcom Assistance Program to assist local organizations and landowners implement small-scale projects that advance or implement local priorities identified for the Puget Sound Action Agenda.

Deliverable: Provide to the PSP locally developed criteria for assistance program; provide copies of proposals received and reviewer forms for selecting projects for funding.

San Juan LIO Contract (Excerpt)

Subtask 3.01 Coordinate funding opportunities for near-term actions or ongoing programs in the Action Agenda, including responses to RFPs.

Track, identify, coordinate and assist grant opportunities and support grant writing and grant management efforts. Provide project assistance to further refine project proposals, project designs, or grant proposals for implementation of near-term actions identified in the Puget Sound Action Agenda.

Deliverable: Provide to the PSP further refined project proposals, project designs, or grant proposals for implementation of near-term actions identified in the Puget Sound Action Agenda.

Island LIO Contract (Excerpt)

Subtask 3.01 Coordinate funding opportunities for Near-Term Actions or ongoing programs in the Action Agenda, including responses to RFPs.

The LIO Coordinator will develop a strategic plan for funding projects to support NTAs and priority pressures in Island watershed. RFPs will be distributed to ILIO members and the ILIO Coordinator will make outreach to relevant owners to facilitate application for funding.

Deliverables: Provide NTA project development strategic plan to PSP
