Spring Carnival and Homespun Spring Bazaar offers weekend fun at the Evergreen State Fairgrounds April 24 - 26

Celebrate spring at the Evergreen State Fair's Spring Carnival April 24 - 26 and the Evergreen Fair Foundation's Homespun Spring Bazaar April 25 - 26 at the Evergreen State Fairgrounds in Monroe.

This event features carnival rides and games, a trout fishing pond, youth activities, a root beer garden, vendors, live Busy Bee quilt show, race car simulator, Daffodil Arabian Duel Horse show, youth dairy show, speedway races, swap meet and historic displays at the Heritage Museum. There is no gate admission charge but the carnival charges for rides and games and the Speedway charges for admission. Parking is \$5 per vehicle.

Butler Amusements will bring a great selection of carnival rides and games to the event. A new ride attraction is the "dragon wagon" from Michael Jackson's Neverland Ranch. The carnival will run Friday, 4 to 10 p.m.; Saturday, 11 a.m. to 10 p.m.; and Sunday 11 a.m. to closing. Discounted carnival ride wristbands are on sale now through April 23. The Evergreen Fair Foundation's Homespun Spring Bazaar hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sunday. Visitors can comfortably view the indoor booths and displays in the climate-controlled 36,000-square-foot Gary D. Weikel Events Center.

Aspiring anglers and first-time fishermen ages 12 and under can catch and release (or keep) a live trout at the Les Schwab Tire Centers popular youth trout fishing pond. The giant 37-inch deep, 20-by-8-foot pond will be stocked with nearly 1,000 trout and hosted by Everett Steelhead and Salmon Club. All gear is provided for this fun-for-the-family event.
