Documents / Information Needed:
Letter of Instruction.
ORIGINAL WRIT and 2 copies <u>IF</u> writ is from SNOHOMISH COUNTY Court:
Writ must be directed to Snohomish County Sheriff
1 CERTIFIED COPY OF WRIT and 3 copies IF from OTHER COUNTIES in
Washington:
From other counties in Washington: 1 Certified Copy of writ and three copies.
NOTE: LEGAL DESCRIPTION MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE WRIT
Property Tax Parcel number is required to record the writ with the auditor. It must be
included in the writ or letter of instruction. This number needs to be provided to us.
If the tax parcel number is not included but the information is available, we cannot write it for you so you must write it for us.

If sheriff is to serve defendants, you must provide the address of the defendants and copies
of documents required to be served as described in RCW 6.25.070. RCW 6.25.070 requires
service of Order to Show Cause, plaintiff's affidavit, homestead statutes, and copy of Notice
of Right to Hearing, if the writ is issued without prior notice. The plaintiff usually takes care
of this service, but may request the sheriff to do so, in which case these documents are served in the same manner as a summons.
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\$250.00 Sheriff Advance Fees.
Form of payment is cash, checks, or money orders. Checks and money orders should
be made payable to SNOHOMISH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (SCSO).
Estimated Advance Fees are required prior to service attempt. If the fees are less, a refund check will be issued. If the fees are more, a bill will be sent for additional
