**Stipulation and Agreed
Order of Paternity**

I. Stipulation

Purpose: The parties to this action agree that there is no genuine issue as to any material fact in this case regarding the paternity of the minor child(ren):

Notice: The Parties acknowledge receipt of a copy of this Stipulation and Order of Paternity and agree that the matter may be presented for entry on an ex parte basis without further notice of presentation.

Stipulation: The Parties stipulate and agree to the entry of the subjoined Findings of Fact, Conclusions Law. The Parties agree that the Order shall be binding.

II. Findings of Fact

It is stipulated by the Parties that:

Jurisdiction: The Court has jurisdiction over the Parties and jurisdiction over the subject matter of this action.

Sexual Intercourse: The Mother engaged in sexual intercourse with the Father within the period of : _____ and _____.

Marriage: The Mother and Father were not married to each other at the time of conception.

Conception: The child was conceived as a result of the sexual intercourse between the Mother and the Father.
