



COLLISION REPORTS **INFORMATION SHEET**

The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office has provided three different options to receive a collision report. If you are seeking the collision report A & B information, which includes; involved parties, vehicle information, insurance information, narrative and diagrams, you may choose any of the three options below. If you are seeking additional information besides the Accident A & B, please submit a public records request via one of the methods shown in item #3 below.

1. Snohomish County Sheriff's Office has partnered with Lexis Nexis E-Crash to provide collision reports online to improve the processing and delivery of collision reports. To obtain a copy of a collision report, please visit <https://ecrash.lexisnexis.com> to register for an account and review the different options to receive a collision report. Please allow 10 days from the date of the collision for the report to be available at E-Crash. There is no fee for citizens involved in the collision. There is a fee for insurance companies and attorneys who are representing individuals involved in a collision.
2. Washington State Patrol (WSP) offers an online service for providing collision reports, called Washington Requests for Electronic Collision Reports (WRECR). This service allows fast and convenient access to collision reports for involved parties. You may search for the following keywords via the Internet: WSP WRECR. With this option, you may purchase a copy of your report, for a fee. See the WSP WRECR website for cost information.
3. Submitting a public records request at the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office, via one of the following methods:

Collision reports are only available to involved parties and/or insurance companies of involved parties, pursuant to RCW 46.52.083.
