**PURPOSE OF THE MEETING**

This was the third and final public meeting. The purpose was to present the preferred concept plan decided on by the ad hoc committee, for public review and comment.

**DISCUSSION**

Bruce Dees welcomed everyone, introduced the ad hoc committee, and recapped the project schedule and process.

Edward Koltonowski, the project traffic engineer, discussed the traffic analysis that was conducted, the existing SR-9 traffic conditions, and the proposed design for the new park entry / exit.

Bruce Dees then recapped the program of activities and facilities and used slides of the preferred concept plan and of typical examples of the proposed elements.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

The public was then invited to comment. The following are comments that were either expressed verbally or written down by meeting attendees:

**VERBAL COMMENTS**

Traffic on SR-9 and the access to and from the Marwood neighborhood dominated the discussion.

Traffic

- Concern was expressed that it will be difficult for park visitors to turn left into the park due to park traffic on SR-9 and that stacking on SR-9, even with extended left turn stacking lane, could impact safety and traffic – if stacking extends beyond the stacking lane onto the traffic lane.

Marwood Trail Access

- Other residents want trail access to the park which would require a bridge at Cutthroat Creek.
- Whether or not a trail connection to Marwood is yet to be determined. Some residents are concerned that a trail connection would encourage the public to park in the neighborhood, taking up parking space for residents.

Field Scheduling

- While scheduled use of the fields will be necessary to control use for organized sports, time for unscheduled use by the community is desired.
- Note: Field use fees will likely be the same as at Tambark Fields.

Traffic

- Push roadway to Bostian Road
