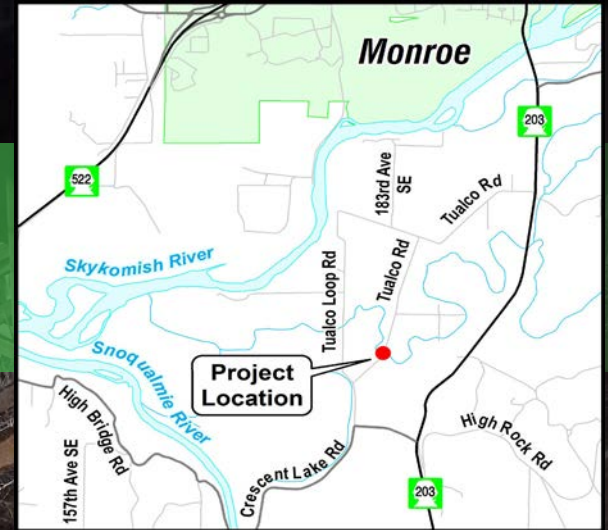


Notice of Land Disturbing Activity and SEPA Threshold Determination

Riley Slough Bridge #155 Replacement



Project Description:

Snohomish County Public Works proposes to replace Riley Slough Bridge #155 on Tualco Road south of Monroe. The bridge would be replaced with a three span, pre-stressed precast concrete girder superstructure. The replacement bridge would span the stream with no intermediate in-stream piers, and would be 32-feet 6-inches wide curb-to-curb with two 11-foot travel lanes with one shoulder 5-feet wide and the other 5.5 feet wide. The project would disturb an estimated 14,100 square feet (0.32 acres).

State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Decision:

On (date), Public Works determined that this project does not have a probable, significant adverse impact on the environment and has issued a Determination of Non-significance (DNS). An environmental impact statement (EIS) under RCW 43.21C.030(2)C is not required. This decision was made after review of SEPA documents and other information on file with this agency. These documents are available for public review upon request.

APPEALS: There is no opportunity for appeal at this time. Pursuant to SCC 30.61.300(10), SEPA appeals related to a shoreline substantial development permit shall be submitted to the state shorelines hearings board together with appeal of the underlying shoreline permit.
