# Accomplishments

- Completed Draft Final 5-Year Ecosystem Recovery Plan
  - Agreement on priorities, strategies, and actions
- Funded (fully or partially) 6 near term actions in both watersheds
  - Living with Beavers Program (SCD)
  - Puget Sound Starts at...My School! (SCD)
  - Integrated Floodplain Management (SnoCo)
  - Financing Options for Healthy Onsite Sewage Systems (SnoCo)
  - Mountains to Sound: Collaborative K-12 Education Pilot Program (Stilly Tribe)
  - Snohomish Estuary Clean-up (MRC)



# Drivers for Change

- Process and planning heavy
- Signs of integration within established watershed groups
- Meeting redundancy
- Competition rather than support
- Lack of funding for implementation
- Lack of elected official engagement
- Not effective



# 2017 Goals

- Survey the SWC, Forum, and LIO
- Subcommittee established to review and refine LIO structure products (i.e. identity/vision, alternative structure models, membership support)
- Test alternative models
- Refine preferred structure based on vision
- Refine membership criteria based on structure
- Present preferred structure to LIO EC, ECB/LC, SWC, and Forum
