#### Agenda Items:

##### 1) Transition Plan Projects Update

- Committee would like to make a field visit to the 2016 Transition Plan upgrade projects (128 ST SW) and the planned 2017 Transition Plan upgrade project locations (4<sup>th</sup> AVE W from Mariner P&R to 108 ST) this month.
- Need to look into ramp designs that make the outside returned curb line up perpendicular to the curb line on the opposite side of the road.

- Staff will plan outreach to local agencies/elected officials (Nadeem looking into hosting a mini forum/panel discussion).
- Public Works should consider getting local/regional ADA coordinators/regulators together to try and develop consistent design guidance amongst agencies.
