About Snohomish County Tomorrow Steering Committee and Community Advisory Board

Snohomish County Tomorrow (SCT) is a cooperative forum with representatives from Snohomish County and 19 of its cities as well as from the Tulalip Tribes. The group's primary function is to oversee Countywide Planning Policies – written policies on growth management from which the county and cities' comprehensive plans are developed.

The Steering Committee is composed of elected officials. It reviews recommendations from other SCT committees and may forward their decisions to the County Council, Puget Sound Regional Council or other regional or state organizations.

The Community Advisory Board represents all facets of Snohomish County's communities, including nonprofit organizations, special purposed districts, business/industry and financial institutions, and the building and real estate community.
