Council Announces Public Budget Forums

The Snohomish County Council will hold two public forums related to the county's 2015 budget development process.

The Council encourages the public to attend these forums and to voice their support for the issues that matter to them in the upcoming year's budget. "These public forums are an essential avenue for citizens to make their voices heard," said Council Chair Somers. "Hearing what is most important to county residents makes a huge impact on the decisions the Council will make for 2015."

The first forum will be held on Monday October 13 at 6:30 pm in the Administrative East Building on the county campus, also known as the Robert Drewel Building, on the eighth floor in the Jackson Board Room (3000 Rockefeller Avenue, Everett, WA 98201).

The second forum will be held on Monday October 20 at 6:30 pm at McCollum Park (620 128th St SE, Martha Lake, WA 98208).
