

# Road Construction In Your Area

## Maple Rd and Ash Way Intersection Improvements



August 2017

Flooding events originating from Swamp Creek force the closure of the Maple Rd and Ash Way intersection, along with the Interurban Trail, multiple times a year.

Snohomish County and the city of Lynnwood are working together on a project to help ease flooding by reconstructing the intersection above the flood elevation and increasing drainage capacity.

We want to share the current status of the intersection improvement project, along with what you can expect to see in the future.

### Proposed Improvements

- Reconstructing approximately 700 feet of Maple Rd and 600 feet of Ash Way/Interurban Trail using structural slabs on top of pin piles, pile caps, and grade beams
- Raising the intersection roughly five feet and a minimum of six inches above the existing 25-year flood elevation of Swamp Creek to ease flooding issues
- Increasing the drainage system's capacity to reduce upstream flooding
- Installing new fish-passable culverts on Maple Rd and Ash Way

### Timeframe and Local Impact

- The project is scheduled to take place during the spring of 2018 and will last five months.
- The intersection, along with a section of the Interurban Trail, will be closed during construction.
- Detour routes are planned during the construction window for both the two roads and the Interurban Trail.
- Some businesses will not have access from Ash Way and the Interurban Trail during construction, but general access to all businesses will be made available.
- Construction work and the subsequent noise will only take place from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Friday.

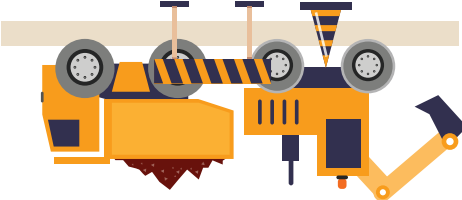
