



Snohomish County District Court Mental Health Court (MHC)

Snohomish County Mental Health Court is an abstinence based court that prohibits its participants to possess or consume alcohol, marijuana/medical marijuana, non-prescribed drugs or synthetic drugs such as spice.

Snohomish County Mental Health Court recognizes the need for a more straightforward policy on prohibiting the use of medical marijuana, with or without a prescription or authorization. MHC realizes that a policy allowing for medical marijuana produces a detrimental effect on the persons being served in MHC and creates a perception that the use of marijuana may be permitted. MHC serves a group of vulnerable individuals with mental health challenges, drug addiction, or co-occurring disorders where a focus on abstinence is a key component to an individual's recovery and treatment.
