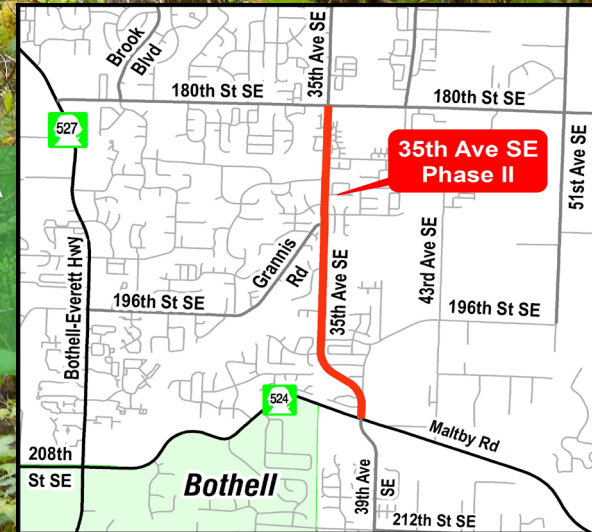


# Notice of Land Disturbing Activity and SEPA Threshold Determination

## 35th Avenue SE: SR524 to 180th Street SE Phase II Corridor Improvements



### Project Description:

Snohomish County Public Works proposes the following improvements to a 1.5 mile section of the 35th Avenue SE corridor between 180th Street SE and SR 524: road widening to three lanes with a 12-foot two-way left-turn lane, 11-foot outside through lanes, 5-foot bike lanes, 5-foot landscaped planter strips 5-foot sidewalks, curb and gutter, retaining walls, and a traffic signal at 184th Street SE. Drainage improvements would include storm-water conveyance, detention, and water quality treatment. Utilities would also need to be relocated in order to accommodate the proposed improvements.

### State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Decision:

On January 17, 2018, Public Works determined that this project does

not have a probable, significant adverse impact on the environment and has issued a Determination of Non-significance (DNS). An environmental impact statement (EIS) under RCW 43.21C.030(2)C is not required. This decision was made after review of SEPA documents and other information on file with this agency. These documents are available for public review upon request.

### SEPA Appeal:

There is no opportunity for appeal at this time. Pursuant to SCC 30.61.300(3), SEPA appeals related to a land disturbing activity, which is a Type 1 decision, shall be submitted to the Hearing Examiner together with appeal of the underlying permit.
