Topic: 10 year Status and Trend Report

Background:

10 Year Status and Trend Report will be a high level summary of our progress since the completion of the *Snohomish River Basin Salmon Conservation Plan* in 2005. The report is intended to:

- Provide some assessment of restoration gains relative to losses (status and trends)
- Discuss changes that have occurred since the plan (SBPP, SLS, FFF)
- Highlight interesting, relevant topics (lessons learned, move toward multi-benefit, emerging issues – climate change)
- Provide a funding and project summary

Report will be a tool the lead entity and Forum members can use to tell the story of our gains and challenges in salmon recovery in the Snohomish Basin. We anticipate the report will:

- set the stage for a plan update (update to goals, strategies, other?)
- be used as a communication tool to reinvigorate partner commitment to achieving salmon recovery goals
