**Elected Official Salary Schedule  
January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2018**

The Snohomish County Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials, pursuant to chapter 2.105 SCC and Charter Section 6.120, hereby adopts the following salary schedule for elected officials for 2017 and 2018:

1. The annual salaries paid to the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017, shall be the amounts stated below.

County Councilmember	\$117,534
County Executive	\$174,226
Sheriff	\$152,329
Assessor	\$129,786
Auditor	\$129,786
Clerk	\$129,786
Treasurer	\$129,786

2. The annual salaries paid to the elected officials identified in Section 1 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2018, shall be the annual salary paid to the official for fiscal year 2017 increased by two-and-a-half percent (2.5%).
3. In addition to the amount established in Sections 1 and 2 above for a County Councilmember, the annual salary of the Chair of the County Council shall include an additional amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the regular Councilmember salary for that year.
4. The salary paid the Prosecuting Attorney shall be equal to the salary paid Superior Court Judges, including adjustments thereto, as determined by the Washington Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected Officials under Article XXVIII of the Washington Constitution and chapter 43.03 RCW. Salary adjustments shall be applied to the salary of the Prosecuting Attorney according to the same schedule as adjustments are applied to the salary of Superior Court Judges.

Pursuant to SCC 2.105.060 (1), Erica Temple certifies as follows:

That this salary schedule has been adopted in accordance with the provisions of chapter 2.105 SCC, Charter Section 6.120 and the rules, if any, of the Commission.
