

## NOTICE OF RULE ADOPTION

### SNOHOMISH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The following described rule is adopted pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 2.01, 2.68, 13.01, and 30.82 Snohomish County Code (SCC).

**Notice Date:** May 18, 2018

**Rule Title:** PDS Director's Rule 18-02

**Adopted Rule:** Snohomish County Planning and Development Services (PDS), in conjunction with Snohomish County Public Works, has adopted PDS Director's Rule 18-02. In adopting the rule, it supersedes PDS Rule 5510.

Rule 18-02 clarifies the process and requirements for construction approval prior to and the delayed installation of the final placement of hot mix asphalt paving on public and private road network elements within certain developments. Such approval and delay may only be authorized for eligible subdivisions, short subdivisions, and residential developments specified under SCC 30.84.105 and eligible subdivisions and short subdivisions under SCC 13.10.124.

While the rule is substantially similar to PDS Rule 5510, it updates terminology used, outlines a new temporary construction easement requirement, adds linked citations, and better aligns with newer practices such as using a standard worksheet to determine bonding cost estimates.

This rule complies with Chapters 13.05, 13.10, 30.41A, 30.41B, 30.84, and 30.86 SCC as well as the Engineering Design and Development Standards (EDDS).

The rule was adopted on May 11, 2018 and becomes effective on May 18, 2018.

**Decision:** The PDS Director, in conjunction with the County Engineer, has approved the rule. This Notice of Rule Adoption is being submitted to the clerk of the County Council, published in the County newspaper of record (The Herald), and sent to all persons who submitted written comments.

**Request for County Council Review:** The rule adoption may be reviewed by the County Council upon written request by an interested person, if such request is submitted to the PDS Director or the contact person listed below no later than 120 days after the notice date shown above. No other formal appeal opportunity is available.
