To the Examiner:

I'd planned to come to Thursday's public comment session, but am in the throes of a family crisis (2 day old grandchild in NICU at Swedish, and I'm caring for her 2-year old brother). I wrote earlier, but didn't include my most salient issue, as I was going to express it at the meeting. Hence this, my second email:

I am concerned that BSRE doesn't have much respect for our neighborhood or the state or county regulations -- it is clearly not paying attention to the deadlines, nor cares enough to fully (or in a timely fashion) address the environmental impact issues. I wonder what else it will disregard, disrespect or out-right ignore.

It seems this behavior is likely to be indicative of the organization's ability or interest in paying attention to the details that impact us all, now and in the future. I think they're not community players, and it's scary to think of all that would go on down there with an organization of this sort.

I hope you'll fully consider what their behavior, their disregard for the rules and regs of the county and state mean as to their intent to do right by the people of Shoreline and King and Snohomish counties, and even their own renters/buyers in the long run.

It is valuable property and there will likely be better "suitors" in the wings. Let's wait for the right group, let's do this right.
