Facility will be operating with one compactor May 16 through the afternoon of May 17, 2018

EVERETT, Wash., May 14, 2018 – Snohomish County's Airport Road Recycling & Transfer Station will be reducing capacity for maintenance May 16 and 17, 2018 for unanticipated equipment repairs. Customers should anticipate longer than usual wait times while this work is being performed. Snohomish County Public Works anticipates returning to normal operation Thursday afternoon, May 17, 2018.
