



**Elected Official Salary Schedule
January 1, 2019 – December 31, 2020**

The Snohomish County Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials, pursuant to chapter 2.105 SCC and Charter Section 6.120, hereby adopts the following salary schedule for elected officials for 2019 and 2020:

1. The annual salaries paid to the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019, shall be the amounts stated below:

County Councilmember	\$123,484.16
County Executive	\$183,939.10
Assessor	\$136,356.42
Auditor	\$136,356.42
Clerk	\$136,356.42
Sheriff	\$160,821.35
Treasurer	\$136,356.42

2. The annual salaries paid to the County Councilmembers, Assessor, Auditor, Clerk, and Treasurer identified in Section 1 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2020, shall be the annual salary paid to the elected official for the fiscal year 2019 increased by two-and-a-half percent (2.5%).
3. The annual salaries paid to the County Executive and Sheriff identified in Section 1 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2020, shall be the annual salary paid to the elected official for the fiscal year 2019 increased by three percent (3.0%).
4. In addition to the amount established in Sections 1 and 2 above for a County Councilmember, the annual salary of the Chair of the County Council shall include an additional amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the regular Councilmember salary for that year.
5. The salary paid to the Prosecuting Attorney shall be equal to the salary paid to Superior Court Judges, including adjustments thereto, as determined by the Washington Citizens' Commission on Salaries for Elected Officials under Article XXVII of the Washington Constitution and chapter 43.03 RCW. Salary adjustments shall be applied to the salary of the Prosecuting Attorney according to the same schedule as adjustments are applied to the salary of Superior Court Judges.
