

HIGH SCHOOL TRANSITION COORDINATION

**Provide support to adults with developmental disabilities
in their transition from school to adult services and employment**

Targeted Outcomes:

- Identify, contact and provide outreach to individuals that are 18-21 years-of-age and connected to the State Developmental Disabilities Administration.
- Assist individuals and their families to plan for their future and connect to personal and community resources specific to their individual needs.
- Provide support with navigating the adult service system and provide an overview of services available.
- Provide information and support during transition / Individual Education Planning meetings.
- Coordinate employment services with Snohomish County, DDA (Developmental Disabilities Administration), DVR (Division of Vocational Rehabilitation) and DSB (Department of Services for the Blind) as funding is available.
- Provide networking opportunities and information to schools through the Snohomish County Transition Network and provides educational opportunities and informational materials to school personnel.
- Promote the Annual Transition Fair.
- Provide presentations for families, students, school districts or school programs and teachers about planning for life after high school.
- Development of resources, information and trainings for schools and families with agency partners.
- Liaison and consultant to school districts and other counties.
- Manage Parent Distribution List that provides information about transition and local, state and national resources.
