



SNOQUALMIE/SOUTH FORK SKYKOMISH 10 YEAR SALMON HABITAT PROJECTS (2015-2025)

CHARTING THE COURSE OF SALMON RECOVERY THROUGH 2025

This map shows the capital project list for improving salmon habitat in the King County portion of the Snohomish Basin (WRIA 7) from 2015 to 2025. The map illustrates the projects necessary to meet the 2025 milestones of the Snohomish Basin Salmon Conservation Plan. The list includes conceptual project ideas as well as thoroughly vetted capital projects at various phases of design. Government agencies, tribes and non-governmental watershed partners are leading this critical effort including 64 projects totaling \$190 million. These projects will chart the capital trajectory through 2025 on our way to fulfill the plan's ultimate vision of salmon recovery by 2055.
