

Notice of Land Disturbing Activity

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 30.70.050(2) and 30.63B SCC

Project Description:

Approximately 160 linear feet of native soils eroded to within 4 feet of the Index Galena Road shoulder at Mile Post 5.8 during a storm event in the spring of 2011. Snohomish County Public Works proposes to stabilize the existing roadway embankment by constructing a 160-foot long by 40-foot wide lightweight buttress. An 8x25 foot railroad ballast foundation with geogrid layers would be constructed at the base of the proposed buttress, approximately 32 to 35 feet from the existing edge of pavement. Three finger (trench) drains extending down the slope approximately 55 feet from the foundation would be installed. The slope will be covered with mulch and topsoil and seeded with a native planting mixture.

The project site is located on Index Galena Road at Mile Post 5.8, northeast of the Town of Index in Section 2, Township 27N, Range 10E, W.M. of Snohomish County.

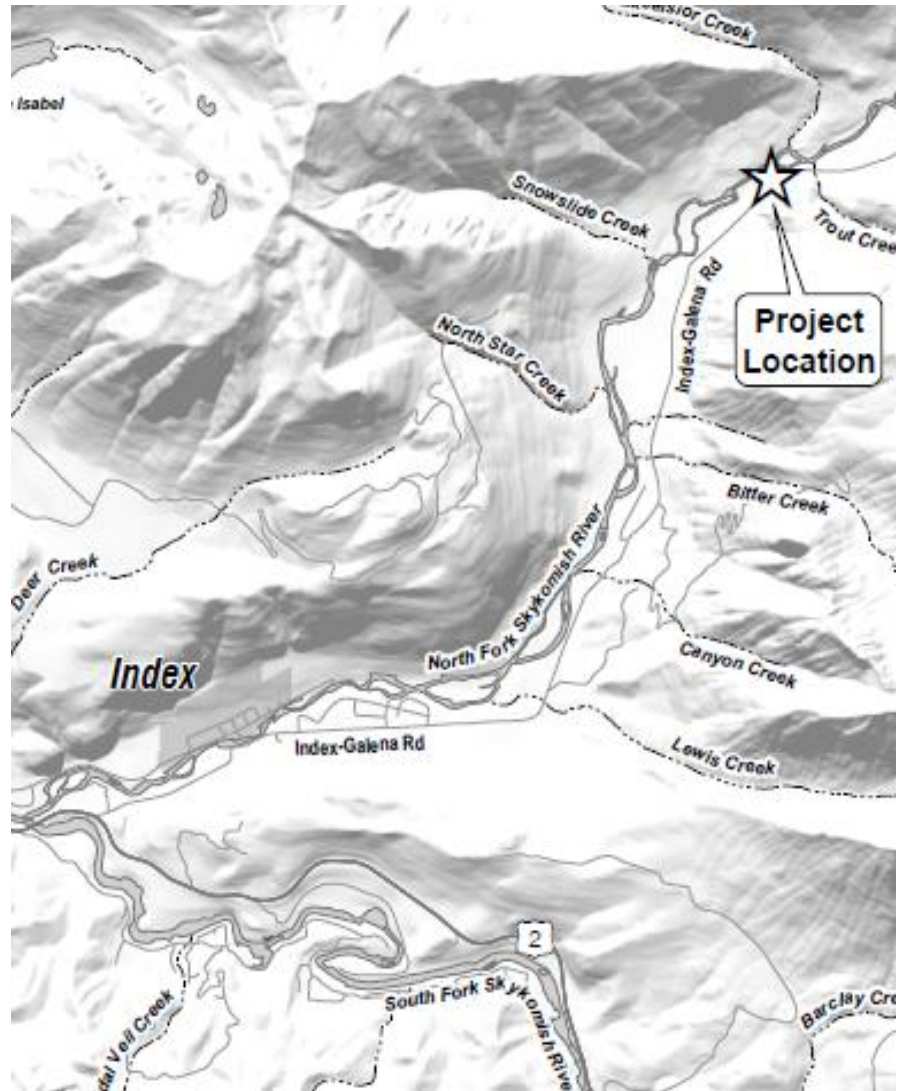
