This free, 12-week program is held in the evenings (6-9:30 PM) with two Saturday field trips and includes classroom training by patrol deputies, detectives and corrections deputies for hands-on participation, tours, and demonstrations in:

- Search and rescue
- Special weapons and tactics (SWAT)
- Gun range
- 911 and dispatch
- Major crime investigations
- Patrol procedures & equipment
- Jail cell extraction
- Vehicle collision investigations
