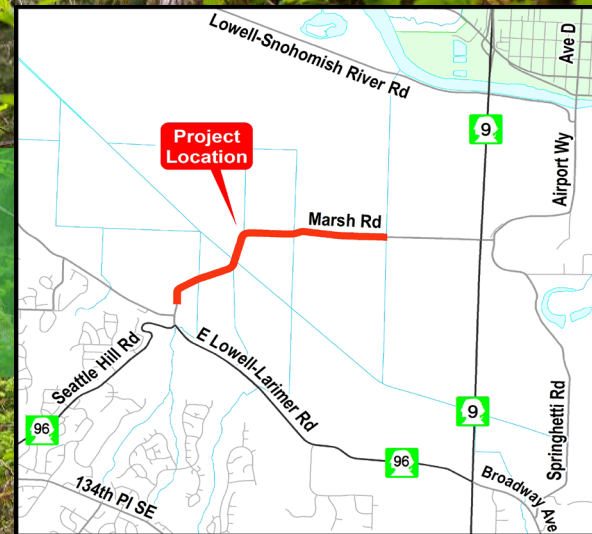


Notice of Land Disturbing Activity

Marsh Road Spot Safety Improvements



Project Description:

This project would upgrade existing guardrail and install new guardrail in multiple locations along Marsh Road. The guardrail improvements would begin at Lowell-Larimer Road and end approximately 4,000 feet west of State Route 9. Minor grading of the road shoulder would be required in some areas. The project will also update signage along Marsh Road.

Project Timing and Earthwork Quantities:

This guardrail project is planned to be constructed in Summer 2019.

Earthwork quantities:

Estimated grading: 7,000 square feet

Estimated Cut/Fill: 250 Cubic yards
