Snohomish County Council Holds Third Night Meeting of 2018 Followed by a District 5 Town Hall with a Panel of Elected Officials

On Monday April 2nd, 2018, the Snohomish County Council will hold their third evening meeting of 2018. The meeting will be held 6:00 PM at the Brightwater Environmental Education and Community Center (22505 WA-9 Woodinville, WA) which is located within Snohomish County Council District 5.

In November of 2016, Snohomish County citizens voted to pass Proposition 5 which requires the County Council to hold an evening meeting in each County Council district at least once each calendar year. It also requires a public hearing be held in the evening on the proposed budget presented by the County Executive and on any proposed ordinance to adopt, amend, or repeal a county comprehensive plan; and repeal inconsistent transition provisions.

Each public meeting includes a public comment period. The Council encourages the public to attend these meetings as they are able, and to come with ideas and suggestions for the Council as they start to plan for the County's 2019 budget.

District 5 Town Hall: At 7pm, or immediately following the County Council meeting, Councilmember Sam Low will hold a town hall meeting at the Brightwater facility. "I have invited county and state elected officials to join me for this meeting. The public will be able to ask questions and meet their local elected representatives. I encourage everyone to come out and participate," Councilmember Low noted.
