PURPOSE:

Relating to Code Change – Hours of Operation and Use of Personal Watercraft at Lake Shoecraft

BACKGROUND:

Title 12.04.010 SCC is intended to regulate conduct and use of vessels in and on fresh water lakes in Snohomish County and not located entirely within the jurisdiction of an incorporated city or town.

SCC 12.06.050 provides that the Snohomish County Council may enact comprehensive restrictions for any given lake to supplement the general restrictions imposed by SCC Title 12 – Recreational Water Use Activities.

SCC 12.08.010 – Water-skiing authorized – "... The county council may enact additional restrictions, but only as a result of a public notice and public hearing, which may restrict time of year, days of week, hours and manner of operation in which such activity is permitted".

11 Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 12.44.030, last amended by
12 Ordinance No. 01-030 on May 2, 2001, is amended to read:

14 **12.44.030 Water-skiing and personal watercraft regulations—Lake**
15 **Roesiger, Flowing Lake, Lake Shoecraft.**

17 Water-Skiing and use of personal watercraft on Lake Roesiger, Flowing Lake,
18 and Lake Shoecraft is subject to the following regulations:

- 19
20 (1) No person may water-ski during the hours of darkness or at times other than:
21
22 (a) Lake Roesiger – 10:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. each day from May 25 to September
23 25 of each year.
24
25 (b) Flowing Lake – 10:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. each day from May 25 to September
26 25 of each year.
27
28 (c) Lake Shoecraft – 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. each day April 1 to September 30,
29 and 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p. m. each day from October 1 to March 31.
30
31 (2) No person may water-ski or tow a water-skier outside of a water-ski course area.
32
33 (3) No person may water-ski or tow a water-skier when course buoy, anchoring
34 device, or other safety buoy is missing, damaged or out of position.
35
36 (4) A person operating a vessel in excess of eight miles per hour shall operate the
37 vessel in a counterclockwise pattern and shall keep the vessel at least 200 feet
38 from any and all shorelines and 100 fee from other vessels and swimmers.
39
40 (5) All persons in motorboats towing water-skiers shall remain seated.
41
42 (6) No person may operate a vessel in excess of eight miles per hour in or upon
43 what is known as the “Middle Lake” of Lake Roesiger.

5 (8) No person may operate a personal watercraft on Flowing Lake except between
6 the hours of 10:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.
