**PURPOSE:**

Approval of an Ordinance proposing to amend SCC 25.20.050 relating to aquatic plant control service charges for real property abutting Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft.

**BACKGROUND:**

- In addition to the annual SWM service charges under SCC 25.20.020, tax parcels abutting the shores of Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft are subject to an additional annual water quality restoration service charge for the purposes of managing and controlling invasive aquatic plants.
- In particular, the county and property owners around Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft have been working to control Eurasian water milfoil aquatic plants at both lakes. The need to continue the milfoil control work has been determined to protect the beneficial uses of the lakes and also to prevent further spreading of the milfoil to other areas of the lakes.
- SCC 25.20.050(2) includes a table with rate categories and additional annual service charges for real properties abutting both lakes. However, these rates are set to expire December 31, 2019.
- Back in May 2019, the correlated lakefront property owners met with county staff and officials to propose a 5-year rate plan with increases in the service charges to fund the milfoil control work.
- The Ordinance would approve the proposal to amend SCC 25.20.050 increasing the aquatic plant control service charges for real properties abutting Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft.
- Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft are located in Council District 1.

11 AMENDING SCC 25.20.050 SERVICE CHARGES FOR AQUATIC PLANT CONTROL

14 WHEREAS, Snohomish County and the property owners around Lake Goodwin and  
15 Lake Shoecraft have been working to control Eurasian water milfoil plants in both lakes; and  
16

17 WHEREAS, there is a need to continue the milfoil control work to protect the  
18 beneficial uses of these lakes and to prevent the milfoil from spreading to additional areas in  
19 the lakes; and  
20

21 WHEREAS, the county council has determined that extending the service charges to  
22 control invasive aquatic plants at lakes Goodwin and Shoecraft is in the public interest and  
23 will protect the beneficial uses of these lakes; and  
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25 WHEREAS, the lake front property owners held a meeting on May 13, 2019 with  
26 county staff and officials to propose a five year rate plan with increases in the service  
27 charges for aquatic plant control to fund the milfoil control work; and

29 WHEREAS, the county council held a public hearing on \_\_\_\_\_, 2019 to  
30 hear public comment on the proposed amendment to chapter 25.20 SCC; and

32 WHEREAS, the county council concludes that chapter 25.20 SCC should be

37 Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 25.20.050, adopted by  
38 Amended Ordinance No. 17-020 on July 5, 2017, is amended to read:

40 **25.20.050 Service charges for aquatic plant control.**

41 (1) In addition to the annual service charges established in SCC 25.20.020,  
42 each tax parcel abutting the shore of Lake Goodwin or Lake Shoecraft shall  
43 be subject to an additional annual water quality restoration service charge for  
44 the purpose of managing and controlling invasive aquatic plants.

45 (2) For the period beginning January 1, ((2015))2020, and ending December  
46 31, ((2019))2024, the rate categories and additional annual service charges  
47 for real property abutting Lake Goodwin or Lake Shoecraft shall be as follows:

(3) The single family rate category or the undeveloped rate category applies to each lake front land parcel classified by the Snohomish County assessor as either single family residential or undeveloped, respectively. The community beach rate category applies to each land parcel having an undivided ownership interest in a lake front parcel used for common beach access. The public and semi-public recreation rate category applies to lake front parcels classified by the Snohomish County assessor as resorts, recreational activities, camping activities, or parks, as well as other publicly owned recreational parcels. Lake front parcels are defined as land parcels abutting the lake shore.

(4) All service charges collected under this section shall be used solely for management and control of non-native invasive aquatic plants in Lake Goodwin and Lake Shoecraft.

(5) A detailed map of the tax parcels subject to the additional service charges established in this section is available in the department of public works and incorporated herein by this reference.
