In the interim, I sincerely hope this letter will suffice for the County to proceed in its application for funding through the Inter Agency Committee.

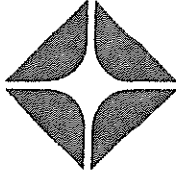


