Richardson Creek Bridge 300 on Woods Creek Road just east of Monroe is scheduled for replacement in 2021. The proposed replacement bridge will include sidewalks and bike lanes for improved mobility. The new, wider-span design will also help improve fish passage at the site.

Snohomish County Public Works is in the preliminary stages of design and is seeking community input on two construction proposals.

Proposed Construction Options

- **Option 1:** Provide a full road closure that is safer for construction, but requires detouring all traffic around the project site. The proposed detour route utilizes Ingraham Road, 132nd St. SE and Wagner Road.
- **Option 2:** Build the bridge in two stages, one half at a time. The daily impact to commuters may be reduced, but the construction would last longer.

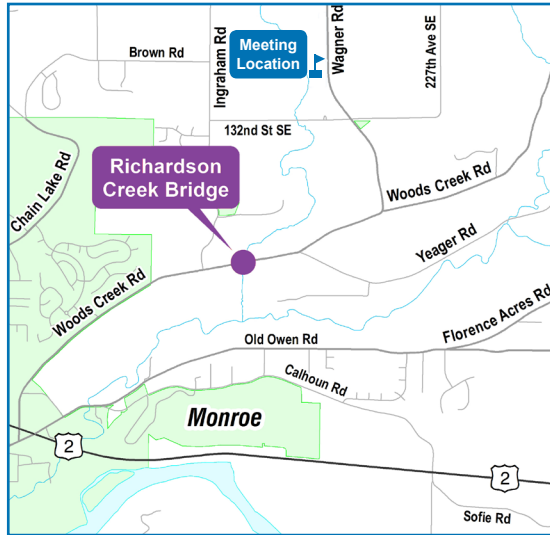
