

Instructions


How to vote



Fill in the oval next to your choice.
Use blue or black ink.
Do not use felt pen.

Vote for only one candidate within the party you marked on your envelope.
Voting for more than one candidate will cancel your vote.


How to change a vote



Draw a line through the entire incorrect choice.

You may then make another selection.

How to vote for a person not on the ballot



Write the name of the person in the space provided at the end of the race and fill in the oval.

Important Presidential Primary Voting Instructions

For your vote to count, you must:

- Mark **one** party box on your return envelope
- Vote for **one** candidate from that party
- Sign and date your return envelope
- Return or postmark your ballot by March 10
