

## Notice of Land Disturbing Activity (LDA) Permit Application and SEPA Threshold Determination of Non-Significance (DNS)

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 30.61 and 30.70 SCC

**Project Description:** Snohomish County Public Works proposes to improve approximately 1.7 miles of the 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SE corridor between 180th Street SE and SR524/Maltby Road. Improvements include: intersection upgrades, two new roundabouts, roadway widening, and construction of two new road sections. The preliminary estimates for cut and fill quantities are 45,500 cubic yards of cut and 35,500 cubic yards of fill over 9 acres. Drainage improvements would include storm-water conveyance, flow control/detention, and water quality treatment. Utility relocations are needed in order to accommodate the proposed improvements.



### **Project Location:**

The project site is located in unincorporated Snohomish County, southeast of the City of Mill Creek. The project limits extend along 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SE between SR524 (Maltby Road) and Sunset Road at 180<sup>th</sup> Street SE. It is located in Sections 16 and 21, Township 27N, Range 5E, W.M. of Snohomish County.

Public Works Road Improvement/Corridor Widening

### **Vesting Date:**

October 4, 2019

### **Permits/Approvals Required:**

Land disturbing activity permit; other applicable federal, state and local permits

### **SEPA Decision:**

On February 14, 2020, the Public Works Responsible Official determined that this project does not have a probable, significant adverse impact on the environment and has issued a Determination of Nonsignificance (DNS). An environmental impact statement (EIS) under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c) is not required. This decision was made after review of SEPA documents and other information on file with this agency. These documents are available for public review upon request.

Submit written or emailed comments on or before 5 p.m., March 9, 2020. Please include your full name and mailing address if submitting comments via email.

### **SEPA Appeal Period:**

The DNS may be appealed pursuant to the requirements of SCC 30.61.300 and must be received no later than 5 p.m., March 2, 2020.

Note: DPW only publishes decisions as required by Snohomish County Code. Persons will receive notice of all decisions that they have submitted written comments on, regardless of whether or not they are published. You may become a party of record for a project by submitting original written comments and request to be a party of record. Only parties of record may subsequently file appeals.

### **To appeal a SEPA decision:**

Submit a written appeal and the \$500 filing fee to PW prior to 5 p.m., published appeal end date. Refer to SCC 30.71.050(5) for details on what must be included in a written appeal. A SEPA appeal also requires that an affidavit or declaration be filed with the Snohomish County Hearing Examiner within seven days of filing the appeal pursuant to SCC 30.61.305(1).
