(5) Draft ADA Pedestrian Facilities Web Map

- Ryan will work on making changes to the web map based on committee member feedback from this meeting and send a link to committee members to beta test before it goes live to the public. Recommend changes/wish list includes:
 - Adding contact information.
 - Adding a description of the grades of the adjacent roadway.
 - Breaking up the compliance categories into four categories: compliant, MEF compliant, non-compliant, missing ramp.
 - Showing what facilities are currently being worked on.
 - Displaying completed work as a separate layer.
 - Displaying replacement costs for each facility to be upgraded.
 - Displaying barrier severity priority for removal: high, medium, low.

- Filters that allow one to choose mode choice (bike, mobility devices, walk, etc.) and then have a routing option to show an accessible route from point A to point B selected by the user.
- Add in sidewalk gaps as an option.
- Incorporating other jurisdiction data into the map.
