My wife Anita Veldman and myself are responding to the variance request by BSRE.

BSRE continues to not accept the code requirements set by Snohomish County. The 180 foot variance in building height is not consistent with the surrounding community. The land stability does not seem to be of concern even though there is evidence of slides in the vicinity. The “dark sky” policy of Woodway would be permanently impacted by 180 foot towers casting extensive light in multiple buildings.

The road structure in Woodway as well as Richmond Beach and Shoreline are not constructed to handle the volume of traffic generated by the future residents living in the number of condo’s projected by BSRE. The impact on the surrounding communities is immeasurable.

We support the earlier rejection of the plan and encourage the County to continue to enforce the codes as they have in the past.
