For the continued safety of the public and court staff, the court will be conducting most court hearings using **ZOOM**.

If you do not have access to a smart phone, computer, or landline telephone, or if you require an accommodation under the Americans with Disabilities Act, or require the assistance of an ASL interpreter, you must attend your next hearing in person.

ZOOM Hearings:

There is one Zoom link for all dependency matters, one Zoom link for all juvenile offender matters, and one Zoom link for all shelter care hearings. Each month these Zoom links change. You can find the Zoom links and call-in information on the website:

You can join Zoom with a smart phone or laptop, or you can call in to Zoom using the telephone number, meeting ID, and password provided.

Please join the Zoom meeting five minutes before the start of your hearing. You will be muted until your specific hearing is called. Please do not leave the meeting until the Judge has told you your hearing is done.
