Pursuant to the authority given to this Court through Washington State Supreme Court Orders 25700-B-602 through B-646 (and any superseding or modified orders) and the authority granted to the Presiding Judge of Snohomish County Superior Court pursuant to GR 29, this Amendment to Emergency Order #14 shall be in effect immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:

Paragraph 42, subsection B is amended as follows:


- B. Through August 1, 2021, the Minor Guardianship Calendar is scheduled and will be heard on Wednesdays at 10:00am in Courtroom 1E. Effective August 2, 2021,

the Minor Guardianship Calendar will be scheduled and will be heard on Wednesdays at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom 1E. Hearings on Minor Guardianship actions filed pursuant to RCW 11.130, known as the Uniform Guardianship Act, shall be heard on that calendar, unless otherwise set by the Court. This calendar exists because of a change in the law, and not due to the current pandemic. All provisions of Emergency Order #14 which are not superseded by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
